Sub: Estt - Promotion to the cadre of Superintendent of Central Excise-Reg.

2. On promotion S/Shri. V. Jayaraj and A. Lakshmikantan respectively are placed immediately below their Senior Shri. P. Suresh Kumar (Sl.No. 26) who was promoted to the cadre of Superintendent vide Order No. 97/2006 dated 30/06/2006 issued from file C.No. II/3/23/2006 Estt. I and above their juniors Smt. Marykutty Chacko (Sl.No. 27) and Shri. Gopakumar E.K. (Sl. No. 28).

3. Consequent on the notional promotion, S/Shri. A. Lakshmikantan and V. Jayaraj are eligible for fixation of pay and are not eligible for arrears of pay.

4. The officers will be on probation for a period of two years from the date of assumption of charge as Superintendent of Central Excise & Customs and will not be considered for further promotion / retention unless they complete the probation period satisfactorily.

5. They may exercise their option for fixation of pay in terms of D.O.P.T. O.M. Dated 26/09/1981 and 05/07/1999 within one month.

6. The above promotions are subject to the further proceedings against the decision dated 1/2/2007 of the CAT (EB) in OA.No. 530/2004.
